

Fishery Notice - Fisheries and Oceans Canada

Subject: FN1184-RECREATIONAL - Salmon - Chum - Area 29 - Fraser River Mouth - Fishing Opportunities

Waters: Subareas 29-6, 29-7, 29-9 and 29-10 (Fraser River mouth).

Management measure: Effective November 2 until December 31, 2020:

- The daily limit for chum salmon is four (4).
- You may not retain coho salmon, except in that portion of Subarea 29-10 that lies easterly of a line from Gower Point to the Tango 10 light Buoy, then to the northern tip of Lulu Island where you may retain two (2) hatchery marked coho per day.
- You may not retain chinook, wild coho, sockeye or pink salmon.

Daily Limits: The daily limit for all species of Pacific salmon from tidal and fresh waters combined is four (4). Individual species limits also apply.

Variation Order numbers: 2020-RFQ-609, 2020-RFQ-610, 2020-RCT-612

Notes:

The aggregate daily limit for all species of Pacific salmon from tidal and non-tidal waters combined is four (4). Individual species limits also apply.

Barbless hooks are required when fishing for salmon in tidal waters of British Columbia.

The term "marked" means a hatchery fish that has a healed scar in place of the adipose fin.

Sport anglers are encouraged to participate in the Salmon Sport Head Recovery program by labelling and submitting heads from adipose fin-clipped chinook and coho salmon. Recovery of coded-wire tags provides critical information for coast-wide stock assessment. Contact the Salmon Sport Head Recovery Program toll free at (866) 483-9994 for further information.
